Genesis 1 vs 27

'27 So God created mankind in His own Image, in the Image of God He created them; male and female he created them.'

Job 38 vs 29

'29 From whose womb comes the ice? Who gives birth to the frost from the heavens '

Here I want to point out that even the seasons and its elements have a birth place. How much more you a being specially created in His image.

1 John 4 vs 4

'4 You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.'

You have a unique bloodline because you are born from and by God. You share a motherly bond.

1 John 4 vs 7

Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.

Love is God and God is Love.

The whole chapter of 1 John 4, talks about God's Love, its representation and how to walk in love. Do take time to read and refresh your tired soul.

Comfort, Contentment and Consolation

Isaiah 66 vs 13

I speak healing and comfort to every broken heart and mind. May the Father give you comfort and peace. Let Him love you and keep you. Allow your tears to flow for you've got a comforter. A mother who is on your side. A mother who is proud to love you, hug you, kiss you, cook for you, cover you, bless you and cherish you.

You are not forgotten

Isaiah 49 vs 14 – 16

14 But Zion said, "The Lord has forsaken me, the Lord has forgotten me,"

15 "Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne? Though she may forget, I will not forget you!

16 See, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands; your walls are ever before me.

The Psalms in the Bible written by King David of Israel has a chapter, Psalm 131 which he talks about his contentment, consolation and dependence on God in the perspective of God as his Mother.

Psalm 131 vs 2

'2 But I have calmed and quieted myself, I am like a weaned child with its mother; like a weaned child I am content.'

Fierce Mother Bear, Mother Eagle and Mother Hen

Hosea 13 vs 8

'8 Like a bear robbed of her cubs, I will attack them and rip them open; like a lion I will devour them- a wild animal will tear them apart.'

This brings to mind the fierce love of a mother who would do anything to protect her own. The thought of her children being in a situation that they need help, a mother would come rushing even in a weak state. You hear stories of mothers making bold moves and decisions for her children. A woman known as a weaker vessel has strength like no other for her children. How much more God our Heavenly Creator. Our Origin and Source of our bloodline.

Deuteronomy 32 vs 11

'11 like an eagle that stirs up its nest and hovers over its young, that spreads its wings to catch them and carries them aloft.'

Our protector and He keeps watch over His own. His longing to have His children gathered and near Him. Some of you know of His Love and some of you have witnessed it but have refused. Why?

Matt 23 vs 37

'37 "Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you were not willing.'

I want you to pause, take a moment to reflect.

Teaching with Kindness

Jeremiah 31 vs 3

'3 The Lord appeared to us in the past, saying: "I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness.'

The Father wishes to teach with kindness he doesn't come to condemn any of His children. He seeks to be on your side every day and give you the secrets to wisdom, insight, love and your inheritance.

Father is of A Heavenly Bloodline, Royalty like no other and you have a place in His Kingdom. In His House.

This scripture Hosea 11 vs 1 -11 talks about the anger and unhappiness God experiences when His children are not with him and have deliberately turned away from Him. However, when you continue to read you realise His anger mellows or goes down or cools off and is replaced with compassion.

Hosea 11 vs 8-9

'8 "How can I give you up, Ephraim? How can I hand you over, Israel? How can I treat you like Admah? How can I make you like Zeboyim? My heart is changed within me; all my compassion is aroused.

9 I will not carry out my fierce anger, nor will I devastate Ephraim again. For I am God, and not a man- the Holy One among you. I will not come against their cities. '

I write to you and say for our Father, He is God and not man. He has so much love that He gives even in anger. Like a mother who sees the pain her child makes her go through but when she sees her image in that child results in compassion.

The moment we open our eyes to see and receive its like a switch He descends to where we are and embraces us with warmth and fire. Faster than the speed of light. Like wings stretched to cover and lift high more than just an embrace. He is filled with Joy and trembling.

I pray you feel the wings of your Father wrap around you. He clothes you. He wipes your tears. He cleanses you. He raises you up and places you on His lap. He pats your head. He places your head on His bosom.

John 3 vs 16-17

'16 For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

17 For God did not send His Son to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.'

Father loves you deeply more than you can imagine.



THE LOVE OF A FATHER

Identity a new surname.

The testament of your stand in God as a son or daughter is the spirit you received. That translates to a new surname. Just like how you adopt the surname of your earthly father once born, you adopt The Heavenly Name your Heavenly Father has given you. Because you have just been reborn in Him.

So, I urge you to ask Father, what is the name He has given you, I promise Father would answer you.

Romans 8 vs 14 – 17

'14 For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God.

15 The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by Him we cry, "Abba, Father".

16 The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.

17 Now if we are children, then we are heirs-heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.'

In any situation or time in your life, in victory, joy, suffering, confusion, laughter, promotion, celebration you can always say "Abba, Father".

His spirit is there to teach, discipline and guide.

Provision and Love of A Father

Here Jesus speaks of the Father as a provider and his love for you when you call on Him. My brother and sister you have a right to speak to the Father In Jesus Name. So, make use of it. Father loves to speak with us and when you ask be still to listen to Him speak back to you.

John 16 vs 23 – 24

'23 In that day you will no longer ask me anything. Very truly I tell you, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name.

24 Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.'

His love for us is real no matter the circumstance, the tribe you are, your skin colour, your language anything you can think of. He is ready to meet our needs so please don't shy away from Him. It's okay to speak.

John 16 vs 26-27

'26 In that day you will ask in my name. I am not saying that I will ask the Father on your behalf.

27 No, the Father himself loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God.'

To guide and lead

Jeremiah 31 vs 9

'9 They will come with weeping: they will pray as I bring them back. I will lead them beside streams of water on a level path where they will not stumble, because I am Israel's Father, and Ephraim is my firstborn son.'

Father wants to lead you and guide you on a path to victory. I want you to ask Father what paths to take and ask for

guidance to walk and talk like Him. Ask Him what's on His heart for you. For He seeks to lead you by streams of water, on a level path where you will not stumble and even if you stumble, He is going to pick you up.

Don't doubt His Instruction

Job 38 vs 28

'28 Does the rain have a father? Who fathers the drops of dew?

The times and seasons, rules and laws are given by Father. To be able to move in this world successfully amidst all the ups and down you must seek the counsel of the Father,

I urge you to read the full chapter of Job 38. Here Father speaks about himself and His plans. It's wonderful.

Be Wise and not Foolish

Always give honour and glory to Father do not be prideful and disobedient because of his love, for He disciplines His children as a Father would.

Deuteronomy 32 vs 6

'6 Is this the way you repay the Lord, you foolish and unwise people? Is he not your Father, your Creator, who made you and formed you?'

The whole of chapter 32 talks about the goodness of God to His Children and the results of disobedience and taking Him for granted.

I pray you get to a point that you will rather Fathers discipline than His back turned against you. For the enemy has no good plans for you. For the devil seeks to steal, kill and destroy.

And he begins by stealing your heart away from the Father. So, seek the Father in all things, that all will be well with you.

Friends and not servants

John 15 vs 13-15

'13 Greater love has no one than this; to lay down one's life for one's friends.

14 You are my friends if you do what I command.

15 I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you.'

Though many say we are called to serve, serving doesn't make you servants. You have been given an intricate map of the road and a plan of the building of Fathers Kingdom. You have a special role to play this shows you are trusted by the Father. Jesus trusts you and loves you like a friend to give you this task to undertake.

Ecclesiastes 4 vs 9-12

'9 Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labour:

12 Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves. A cord of three strands is not quickly broken.

'19 Even now my witness is in heaven; my advocate is on high.

'5 No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you.'

9 about sin, because people do not believe in Me;

11 and about judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned.

12 "I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear.

13 But when He, the Spirit Of Truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth, He will not speak on His own; He will speak only what He hears, and He will tell you what is yet to come.

14 He will glorify Me because it is from me that he will receive what He will make known to you.

15 All that belongs to the Father is Mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from Me what he will make known to you.'

Amen! May you receive all keys to hidden wisdom, secret doors, new inventions, plans, blueprints, insights and many more as the Holy Spirit gives. In Jesus Name Amen.

Always have obedience so you receive anything.

1 John 3 vs 22

'22 and receive from Him anything we ask, because we keep His commands and do what pleases Him.

Always heed His counsel.
